Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.50 dated 30.03.2021 under Section 148, 149, 323, 324, 326, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Radaur, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that as per allegations in the FIR, registered at the instance of complainant Jogender Singh, the petitioners have caused injuries to him as well as another victim Surta Ram, though the details of the injuries inflicted by all the accused are specified in the FIR.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, at the very outset, submits that

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the matter has been settled between the parties, considering the fact that they are residents of the same village and the petitioners have filed a petition i.e. CRM-M-24615-2021, praying for quashing of the FIR on the basis of compromise and this Court has already issued notice of motion, as the complainant appeared through his counsel and acknowledged the compromise and the parties were directed to record their statements and report was sought from the trial Court.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Deepak Kumar Grewal, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State while Mr. Rajesh Nain, Advocate has appeared on behalf of the complainant.

Learned State counsel could not dispute the factum of compromise, as learned counsel appearing for the complainant as well as victim has again acknowledged that there is a compromise between the parties.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, considering the aforesaid submissions, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is granted the concession of anticipatory bail subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
