Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.220 dated 05.09.2018, under Sections 376 of IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

By virtue of the order dated 14.07.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurnam Singh has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the same, the interim order dated 14.07.2021, is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
