Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.0260 dated 28.5.2021 registered under Sections 376, 328 and 506 IPC at Police Station, City Barnala, District Barnala.

By virtue of the order dated 6.7.2021, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
