1. This petition has been filed against the detention of goods and prayer is to release the goods along with conveyances on payment of tax and penalty along with security other than cash or bank guarantee.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that actually no notice has been received by him for any proceeding and the goods are detained illegally.
3. Notice of motion.
4. On advance notice, Mr. Pankaj Gupta, Addl. A.G., Punjab appears and accepts notice and states that in fact due notices were issued to the petitioner (the receipt of which is denied by the petitioner).
5. Be that as it may. It has been agreed by learned counsel for the parties that the petitioner shall appear on 9.7.2021 before the officer who has intercepted and seized the goods and thereafter, the officer shall pass an order in accordance with law within one week.

- 7. Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
