This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of pre-arrest bail has been moved by petitioners in case FIR No.272 dated 23.05.2021 under Sections 148, 201, 323, 325 and 506 IPC read with Section 149 IPC [later on Section 379 IPC was deleted, whereas Section 3 (2) (va) of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, was added], registered at Police Station Kaithal City, District Kaithal.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Deputy Superintendent of Police Vivek Chaudhary, submits that in compliance of order dated 01.09.2021 and subsequent order dated 01.10.2021, petitioners namely Piyush Kalra and Anil Kumar have already joined investigation and are not required for further investigation or any kind of custodial interrogation.

In view of above, order dated 01.09.2021 granting interim bail to petitioners namely Piyush Kalra and Anil Kumar, is made absolute. Petitioners namely Piyush Kalra and Anil Kumar shall abide by the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
