1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Learned Addl. AG, Haryana, has furnished copy of order dated 05.07.2021, passed by respondent No.3, in terms of order dated 26.02.2021, in CWP-4644-2021. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof furnished to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal of the same, states that in view of order dated 05.07.2021, he does not wish to pursue the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of as such while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 05.07.2021, by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

3. Since respondent No.3 has passed order dated 05.07.2021, in compliance of order dated 26.02.2021, in CWP-4644-2021, there is sufficient compliance of the writ Court, therefore, no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, is called for against the respondents.

4. Accordingly, the Contempt Petition is disposed of as such while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 05.07.2021, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.
