Present petition has been filed seeking a direction from this Court to the respondents to decide the claim of the petitioner for compassionate appointment.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the mother of the petitioner namely Smt. Babli Rani unfortunately died on 15.01.2020 leaving behind three daughters including the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that other two sisters of the petitioner have already given in writing that they do not want compassionate appointment and the petitioner being fully eligible submitted an application for compassionate appointment in place of her mother. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the claim of the petitioner is not being decided despite the fact that more than one and a half year has elapsed since the death of the mother of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 09.09.2020 (Annexure P-6) to the respondents, which is still pending consideration with the authorities and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the representation of the petitioner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sharad Aggarwal, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection for deciding the representation of the petitioner in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by her in the representation dated 09.09.2020 (Annexure P-6), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the said representation dated 09.09.2020 (Annexure P-6) within a period of three months from the receipt of copy of this order.
