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According to the reply, trial against the petitioner is pending.

Learned State counsel submits that a cancellation report in the FIR registered against the petitioner has already been submitted but the same has not been accepted.

Thus, it is apparent that trial has not yet commenced. In fact, even challan has not been presented. The police has sought cancellation of the FIR on the basis of the investigation. Thus, bar of Section 6(2)(f) of the Passports Act, 1967 is not attracted.

In view of the above, the writ petition is allowed. Respondents No.1 and 2 are directed to issue a passport to the petitioner within eight weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
