Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in the present case, the claim of the petitioner could not be considered due to the order dated 02.05.2019 passed by this Court by which the result of the petitioner was directed to be kept in a sealed cover. Learned counsel for the respondents further submits that in case, a liberty is granted to the respondent-Commission to open the sealed cover, the same will be opened and in case, thereafter, the petitioner is found meritorious enough to be appointed to the post of PGT (Urdu) keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present selection, an appropriate action will be taken within a period of six weeks of the opening of the sealed cover.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has no objection in case, respondent-Commission is allowed to open the sealed cover and consider the claim of the petitioner in accordance with merit he

had secured in the said selection.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent-Commission to open the sealed cover and in case, after the opening of the same, the petitioner is found meritorious enough to be selected and appointed to the post of PGT (Urdu), he be given the said appointment within a period of six weeks as undertaken by the learned State counsel.
