LISA GILL, J.

This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of pandemic, COVID-19.

This writ petition has been filed by the petitioner with the averments that respondent-authorities are proceeding for disconnection of the petitioner's tubewell connection, after issuance of notice dated 10.06.2021 (Annexure P-3) but without passing any specific order thereon despite a reply being filed on behalf of petitioner.

Mr. Sehajbir Singh, Advocate, counsel representing respondents had been directed to seek instructions with regard to the above said averments.

Mr. Sehajbir Singh, Advocate informs that after receipt of a reply dated 10.06.2021, order dated 23.06.2021 has been passed directing disconnection of tubewell connection. Said order, it is further stated was sent through registered post on 23.06.2021 itself to petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that said order has not been received by petitioner till date.

A copy of order dated 23.06.2021 has been circulated on the WhatsApp group created for the purpose of video conferencing and has been received by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of passing of order dated 23.06.2021, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw this writ petition with liberty to file afresh to challenge the said order. It is further submitted that tubewell connection has been in place since the year 2016, therefore, disconnection be stayed for one week from today to enable the petitioner to avail his remedy.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforementioned.

Respondents are restrained from disconnecting the tubewell connection in question for one week from today. Needless to say, this indulgence is not a reflection on the merits of matter or order dated 23.06.2021.
