The matter has been taken up through video conferencing on account of restrictions due to outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic.

Petitioners-Binder Singh and 2 others have jointly filed the present writ petition *inter alia* with the prayer for directing the respondents to count the service rendered by the petitioners on the post of SPOs as qualifying service for the purpose of pensionary/retiral benefits along with further relief as mentioned in the petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners had made a request to the respondents to count the service rendered by the petitioners on the post of SPOs as qualifying service for the purpose of pensionary/retiral benefits.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that for same/similar grievance the petitioners had served a legal notice upon respondents on 06.01.2021 (Annexure P-11).
