Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing impugned transfer order dated 04/07.06.2021 (P-4) issued by respondent No.2, qua the petitioner.

After arguing for considerable time, learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, states that her client would be satisfied in case, legal notice dated 11.06.2021 (P-6) is considered and decided by passing a speaking order expeditiously by the competent authority.

Prayer seems to be justified.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Lavanya Paul, AAG, Punjab, who is present through video-conference, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Learned State counsel raises no objection against the

innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the consensus arrived at between both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.1, to consider and decide the aforesaid legal notice dated 11.06.2021 (P-6), in accordance with law by passing a speaking order sympathetically, preferably within a period of 02 (two) weeks from today.
