This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to the outbreak of pandemic, COVID-19.

It is noticed that in the prayer clause there is no mention of orders dated 05.01.2021 (Annexure P-9) and 16.4.2021 (Annexure P-11) though, order dated 16.4.2021 is mentioned in the head note.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that due to inadvertent mistake yet again in the prayer clause there is no challenge to orders dated 05.01.2021 (Annexure P-9) and 16.4.2021 (Annexure P-11) besides absence of commensurate relevant averments in the writ petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw this petition and prays for one last opportunity to file afresh with better pleadings and proper prayer.

In the interest of justice, this petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforementioned.
