Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 4 for taking action against private respondents No.7 to 10 and to conduct fair inquiry in his complaint/representation dated 23.06.2021 (Annexure P/2) by some higher police official or Crime Branch as respondents No.5 and 6 in league with private respondents are not taking action against them (private respondents No.7 to 10) with further prayer for protection of life and liberty of petitioner and his family members at the hands of private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representation on 23.06.2021 to respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/2, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, to look into and decide representation dated 23.06.2021 (Annexure P/2) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
