On 26.02.2021, the following order was passed by this

Court:-

“Sh. Nakul Sharma, Advocate, representing the petitioner contends that four different departmental inquiries have been initiated against the petitioner in order to harass him.

Ms. Ambika Bedi, AAG, Punjab, has filed the written statement, which is taken on record. She further submits that there are only two departmental inquiries pending against the petitioner which are based on separate charges.

After hearing the arguments at some length, this Bench has requested Ms. Ambika Bedi, AAG, Punjab, to take instructions as to whether it is possible to entrust all the departmental inquiries to one inquiry officer, to be appointed by the government so as to facilitate the conclusion thereof expeditiously. She prays for some time.

Ms. Ambika Bedi, AAG, Punjab, after taking instructions from Sh.Daljit Singh, Patwari-cum-Charge of Panchayat Office, Block Pakhowal, submits that after holding some sort of inquiries, three FIRs
