1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.140 dated 24.06.2020 registered under Section 420 IPC read with Section 13 of the Punjab Travel Professional (Regulation) Act, 2014 at Police Station Division No.5, District Ludhiana.

2. By an order dated 25.09.2020, this Court had granted interim bail to the petitioner and directed him to join investigation.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-State on instructions from ASI Sahib Singh submits that the petitioner has jointed investigation.
