The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.188 dated 02.06.2021 under Sections 498-A, 406 IPC 1860 registered at Police Station Dera Bassi District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that on account of matrimonial dispute between the parties FIR in question was registered against the petitioner. He further submits that pursuant to order dated 07.07.2020, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation. This fact is not disputed by the counsel for the State as well.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Narpinder Singh states that the recovery of dowry articles stand effected and he has instructions to say that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation.

Mr. Dushyant Rana, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and filed his power of attorney, which is taken on record.

He has opposed the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner by

submitting that the recovery of some gold ornaments have not yet been effected.

Heard learned counsel and perused the material available on record.

In view of instructions received by the learned State counsel, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 07.07.2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
