GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioners have approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.95 dated 10.06.2020 registered against them at Police Station Sadar Khanna, Police District Khanna, District Ludhiana, under Sections 323/365/325/326/324/34 IPC and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 09.07.2021, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.
3. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Khanna, has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of accused/petitioners, namely, Dalbara Singh, Kulvir Singh, Mansukhpreet Singh and Navdeep Singh and also of complainant Mandeep Singh as well as of the injured Beant Singh have been

recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves.

4. The complainant Mandeep Singh in his statement has stated that he has no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.
5. The learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Khanna, has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily and out of free will of the parties.
6. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.95 dated 10.06.2020 registered against them at Police Station Sadar Khanna, Police District Khanna, District Ludhiana, under Sections 323/365/325/326/324/34 IPC and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua petitioners.
