Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.P.C.) for grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.55 dated 26.02.2021 under Sections 386, 506 and 34 of IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Khol, District Rewari.

The allegations in FIR are that the petitioner alongwith his co-accused committed extortion of money and gold chain by putting the complainant Shankar Singh in fear of grievous hurt.

Learned counsel for the petitioner as also the complainant state that the matter has been compromised between the parties. The petitioner and complainant are friends. The copy of the compromise has been placed on file as Annexure P-3. The investigation in the case is complete and challan has already been presented. Petitioner is in custody since 01.03.2021.

On the other hand, learned State counsel has opposed the

prayer for regular bail and submits that at the instance of main accused-Jorawar @ Habaria, the petitioner had gone to the house of the complainant and collected Rs. 1,00,000/- (one lac only).

In view of the compromise effected between the parties and also bearing in mind the investigation in the case is complete and the petitioner is in custody since 01.03.2021, no useful purpose would be served by keeping him behind the bars. Hence, petition is allowed. Petitioner-Rahul @ Bhondu is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
