Reply by way of an affidavit dated 12.08.2021 of Partap Singh, Distt. Dev. & Panchayat Officer, Kurukshetra on behalf of respondent No.2 has been filed and the same is taken on record.

Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C, the petitioner seek anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.47 dated 10.04.2019 registered under Sections 409, 420 IPC, at Police Station Babain, District Kurukshetra.

Vide order dated 13.05.2019, passed by this Court, ad interim anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 13.05.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
