Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from DSP-Satpal Singh submits that earlier on two occasions, nothing worth taking cognizance was found in the complaint, however the view was not accepted by the Director, Vigilance Bureau. She contends that the enquiry is pending and the same would be completed within three weeks from today.
