CM No. 18657-CWP of 2021:

This is an application for placing on record the information obtained under the RTI Act (Annexure P-16) on behalf of the petitioner; and for exemption from filing the certified copy of the same.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed. Letter obtained under the RTI Act Annexure P-16 is taken on record and exemption is granted from filing the certified copy of the same.

Main Case:

This petition has been filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India for quashing the impugned order dated 11.5.2021 (Annexure P-1), passed by the Chairman, Permanent Lok Adalat, Chandigarh. , whereby temporary electricity connection in the name of respondent No.3 has been provided. It is further prayed that respondent No.2 be directed not to

install temporary commercial meter in House No.1097, Phase II, Ramdarbar, UT, Chandigarh without taking consent/NOC from the present petitioner/original allottee of the house and; further to remove the above said temporary commercial meter.

The counsel for the respondent No.3 has produced the copy of the order dated 21.10.2021 passed by Permanent Lok Adalat (Public Utility Services), UT, Chandigarh and submts that the Permanent Lok Adalat has decided the matter and the present petition has been rendered infructuous. The same may be dismissed as such.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to file fresh petition if he feels aggrieved against the final order passed by the Lok Adalat, in accordance with law.
