The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing official respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners as they are facing threat from private respondents No.4 and 5.

Counsel for the petitioners contends that a civil litigation is pending between petitioner No.1 and private respondents, as a result of which both the sides have registered criminal cases against each other. Counsel submits that after investigation in the FIR, Annexure P-2, registered by respondent No.4, a cancellation report has been prepared and presented before the Magistrate. Counsel submits that in this background, the petitioners apprehend a threat from private respondents No.4 and 5. He

submits that before approaching this Court, the petitioners have submitted a representation dated 31.05.2021, Annexure P-5, to the police authorities, but no action has been taken thereon. He submits that the petitioners will be satisfied, in case, a direction is issued to the official respondents to look into the representation dated 31.05.2021, Annexure P-5.

Request made by counsel has been considered.

Without expressing any opinion on the allegations levelled in the writ petition or in the representation dated 31.05.2021, Annexure P-5, submitted by the petitioners, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Shaheed Bhagat Singh (SBS) Nagar - respondent No.2 to examine the representation dated 31.05.2021, Annexure P-5, and to take appropriate steps thereon as warranted in accordance with law.

A copy of the representation, Annexure P-5, be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Shaheed Bhagat Singh (SBS) Nagar - respondent No.2, to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
