Present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to reinstate the services of the petitioner as Class-IV employee (service provider) on the premise that he has been acquitted in a criminal case by the Court of competent jurisdiction, vide order dated 03.08.2018 (P-1) and no appeal has been filed against the said order.

At the outset, learned Counsel for the petitioner has pointed out that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case the representation dated 15.03.2021 (P-6), pending with respondent No.2-Deputy Director, Animal Husbandry Department, Fazilka is considered and decided by passing a speaking order expeditiously.

Prayer seems to be justified.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG, Punjab, who is present through Video-Conference, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and innocuous prayer of the petitioner is not opposed by her.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 15.03.2021 (P-6) in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of 03 (three) months from today.
