This is a petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case DDR No. 27 dated 18.9.2015 registered under Sections 307, 427, 148, 149 IPC and under Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act at Police Station Khillchian, District Amritsar in case FIR No. 60 dated 16.9.2015 registered under Sections 307, 148, 149 IPC and under Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act at Police Station Khillchian, District Amritsar (later on challan was presented under Sections 307, 160, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act).

Learned counsel for petitioner as also learned counsel for complainant state that the matter has been compromised between the parties and a petition (CRM-M-11816-2021) for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise has already been filed wherein statements of parties have been recorded. The petitioner is in custody since 20.10.2020.

Considering the fact that compromise has been effected between parties and quashing petition has been filed, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind bars. Hence, petition is allowed. Petitioner Jugraj Singh is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
