The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.312 dated 14.12.2020 registered under Sections 307, 336, 323, 341, 427, 506, 148, 149, 120-B IPC and 25/27 of the Arms Act, at Police Station City Sangrur, District Sangrur.

The operative part of the order dated 08.07.2021, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that one co-accused of the petitioner, namely Shehbaz Khan Ali @ Ali has been granted the concession of the regular vide order dated 09.03.2021 passed in CRM-M-7040- 2021 and the matter stands compromised between the parties. It is further submitted that a petition i.e. CRM-M-21566-2021, praying for quashing of the FIR, on the basis of compromise has already been filed, in which notice of motion was issued on 02.07.2021, noticing the fact that the

complainant's counsel has appeared and has acknowledged the compromise and the parties were directed to record their respective statements. It is also submitted that the petitioner is even ready to pay a compensation of Rs.1.00 lac to the victim, as the matter stands compromised between the parties.

Notice of motion....”

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 08.07.2021, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and has been released on bail.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has not disputed the aforesaid fact.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 08.07.2021 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
