Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 31 dated 26.02.2021, under Sections 324, 323, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' - for short) (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Talwandi Sabo, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the incident is the outcome of a quarrel between the students. The FIR was registered after nine days of the occurrence. It is alleged in the FIR that the petitioner was present along with other accused, but he was empty handed.

This Court, by the order dated 22.11.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Bhupinder Singh, contends that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 22.11.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
