Due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19, the instant case is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *certiorari* for quashing the impugned action of the respondents whereby respondents have failed to revise the pay of husband of the petitioner, namely, late Sh. Sardool Singh w.e.f. 01.01.1996 in complete violation of the policy decision of the Government, and further for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to revise the pay of the husband of the petitioner w.e.f. 01.01.1996 in the scale of 14300-

18150 and to re-fix the pension/family pension as per the revised pay and to release the arrears of pension/family pension w.e.f. 01.12.2011 till the date along with interest @ 18% per annum till actual realization of the same.
