Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.314 dated 17.07.2020 registered under Sections 34, 407 IPC (Section 411 IPC added later) at Police Station Kundli, District Sonapat.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that in compliance of the order dated 08.07.2021, the petitioner has already deposited 02 demand drafts of Rs.2.00 lacs and Rs.3.00 lacs, respectively with the Civil Judge (Sr. Division) in the Court Complex.

Considering the fact that the co-accused of the petitioner namely Ashok Kumar Maheshwari, has already been granted the concession of anticipatory bail as he has volunteered to deposit Rs.2.00 lacs with the trial Court in CRM-M No.31022 of 2020 and also in view of the fact that the allegations against the petitioner are primarily under Section 411 IPC and he has already deposited Rs.5.00 lacs, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is granted the concession of anticipatory

bail subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The amount of Rs.5.00 lacs deposited by the petitioner with the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court, will be kept in an FDR, without prejudice to his right of defence and subject to final outcome of the case.

It will be open for the Investigating Officer to issue a notice in writing to the petitioner to join him in the investigation.
