The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 127 dated 13.04.2021, registered under Section 21 of the NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Rania, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, registered at the instance of ASI Sumit Kumar, while on patrol duty, he noticed that a young boy was coming on a motorcycle and on seeing the police party, he tried to take a U turn, however, in the meantime, his motorcycle turned off and he was apprehended on apprehension. On inquiry, he disclosed his name as Javed Khan, who was driving the motorcycle bearing registration number RJ-31-SN-2674. Thereafter, he was given a notice under Section 50 of the NDPS Act and on search, in the presence of a Gazetted Officer, 50.50 grams of heroin was recovered.

Learned counsel further submits that though the petitioner is

involved in two more FIRs, i.e. FIR No. 312 and FIR No. 443, under the NDPS Act, he is on anticipatory bail in these FIRs.

Learned State counsel has opposed the bail on the ground that petitioner is repeatedly involving in the cases under the NDPS Act as he was granted concession of anticipatory bail in aforesaid cases and thereafter, he again indulged in the similar activities.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner, finding that the Court is not convinced, seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
