Prayer in this petition is for quashing of FIR No. 104 dated 07.05.2021, registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station Gharinda, Rural Amritsar along with all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Admittedly, the challan has not been presented so far, therefore, the present petition is premature.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are being harassed and even on an earlier occasion, they have approached Punjab State Human Rights Commission, wherein an affidavit has been filed by the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar exonerating the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that though the petitioners have been granted concession of interim bail by this Court and the same is now pending for 19.07.2021, however, still the police is

harassing them.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to petitioners to approach Commissioner of Police, Amritsar along with all the supporting documents within a period of two weeks from today. The Commissioner of Police will direct an Officer not below the rank of DSP to monitor the investigation and take into consideration all the documents/orders submitted by the petitioners in their defence and will conclude the investigation only after considering all these documents within a period of two months thereafter.

It is clarified that till the investigation is complete, no coercive action shall be taken against the petitioners in view of the fact that they are on interim anticipatory bail, however, if they are required for any further investigation, the police will issue them a notice in writing to join investigation. However, this clarification is subject to the final order that may be passed in the anticipatory bail petition.
