Case has been called out twice. Learned counsel representing the respondent is not present.

This is wife's petition under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, seeking the transfer of the proceedings in petition filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, bearing HMA 218/2021 titled as 'Manish Kumar vs. Meenu' pending in the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Ambala, to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Nabha, District Patiala.

The petitioner claims that she got married to the respondent on 29.04.2005. She claims that respondent (husband) is already defending proceedings in a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C at Family Court, Nabha. The petitioner claims that she is residing with her parents at Nabha and has no independent source of income.

In view of the aforesaid, the transfer application is allowed. It is directed that the proceedings in the petition filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, bearing HMA 218/2021 titled as 'Manish Kumar vs. Meenu' pending in the Court of Principal Judge, Family

Court, Ambala, be transferred to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Nabha, District Patiala. The transferor court is directed to remit the file of the case to the transferee court forthwith. The parties through their counsel are directed to appear before the Family Court, Nabha on 11.10.2021.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
