The petitioner has challenged the order dated 11.07.2019 (Annexure P-2) whereby she has been declared as a proclaimed person.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had earlier been granted bail in FIR No.345 dated 25.12.2015, registered under Sections 382, 384, 341, 506, 170, 148 IPC at Police Station Kotwali Bathinda, District Bathinda and had been appearing regularly before the trial Court. He further contends that the petitioner could not appear later as she had suffered miscarriage and had instructed her counsel to move an application for exemption but he did not do so and non-bailable warrants were issued from time to time. He also contends that after her divorce, the petitioner had remarried and was staying at another address. The service had been effected at the previous address where the petitioner was not residing. He undertakes that the petitioner shall henceforth appear before the trial Court on each and every date of hearing and would not absent herself except with the prior permission of the Court.

This Court, by the order dated 09.07.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the trial Court and on her doing so, she was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner had appeared before the trial Court on 16.07.2021 in terms of the order of this Court dated 09.07.2021 and had been granted interim bail.

In view of the above, the order dated 09.07.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute and order dated 11.07.2019 (Annexure P-2) passed by JMIC, Bathinda, declaring the petitioner as proclaimed person is set aside.

However, the petitioner shall appear before the trial Court as and when called upon to do so. She shall not absent himself without the prior permission of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed of.
