The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 218, dated 04.04.2021, registered under Sections 307, 506 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Surajkund, District Faridabad.
