Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved by petitioner for issuance of direction to official respondents to perform their legal statutory duty and not to harass the petitioner and her husband namely Dil Mohammad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representations on 28.06.2021 to respondents No.3 and 4— Commissioner of Police, Gurugram and Commissioner of Police, Faridabad, copies of which are available on the file as Annexures P/3 and P/4, but still no action has been taken. He further submits that petitioner restricts her prayer only in the manner that she may not be harassed.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Vikrant Pamboo, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondents No.3 and 4—Commissioner of Police, Gurugram and Commissioner of Police, Faridabad, to look into and decide representations dated 28.06.2021 (Annexures P/3 and P/4) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
