The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing official respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of the private respondents No.4 to 6 and to take appropriate action on the representation (Annexure P-2), which is pending before the official respondents.

Counsel submits that before approaching this Court, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 20.05.2021 (Annexure P-2) to the police authorities, however, the same has not been attended to. Counsel submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the official respondents to look into the representation.

Request made by the petitioner is just and proper.

Without expressing any opinion on the allegations made in the petition or in the representation, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur District Hoshiarpur, respondent No.3 to examine the representation dated 20.05.2021 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner and thereafter to take appropriate steps as warranted in accordance with law.

A copy of the representation dated 20.05.2021 (Annexure P-2) along with the petition be communicated to respondent No.3 so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
