Case is taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This petition has been filed for issuance of directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents and also to take necessary action against them.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, who is a resident of Maharashtra, had purchased a plot at Rajpura, District Patiala, from Central Bank of India, Rajpura Branch in auction. The sale deed of the said plot was executed on 04.12.2019. It is further stated that the private respondents have encroached upon the said plot without executing the registry. Thereafter, the petitioner moved an representation dated 17.06.2021 (Annexure P-4) to Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, but no action has been taken so far.

Learned counsel for the petitioner confines his prayer to direct respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, to decide the representation dated 17.06.2021 (Annexure P-4) moved by the petitioner.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 5-State, at this stage.

Mr. Avtar Singh Sandhu, Addl. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents-State.

In view of the aforesaid prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, to decide the representation dated 17.06.2021 (Annexure P-4) moved by the petitioner within one month in accordance with law after receipt of the copy of this order.
