Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The present petition has been filed for issuance of directions to respondent No.3 not to harass the petitioner at the behest of respondents No.4 to 11 in order to give a criminal tinge to the civil dispute pending before the Civil Courts at S.B.S.Nagar.

Vide order dated 09.07.2021, learned State counsel was directed to seek instructions from respondent No.3.

In pursuance thereof, learned State counsel informs that the respondents No.4 to 11 are the owners of approximately 18 acres of land, which had been given on rent to the petitioner and the same has now been given on rent to some other farmer, but the petitioner is not vacating it and on the application of the petitioner, an inquiry has been initiated in this case by SI Joginder Singh. The petitioner was called in the police station, but he did not join the inquiry.

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At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner will appear and place his grievance before SI Joginder Singh.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to appear before SI Joginder Singh on 20.07.2021 or any other date convenient to him and SI Joginder Singh, and join the inquiry. However, if still aggrieved, the petitioner will be at liberty to approach this Court.
