The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* directing the respondent authorities to release 100% pension, gratuity and GPF of the petitioner which have been illegally withheld alongwith interest @12% on the delayed payment of part pension and leave encashment, for which, representation dated 20.06.2020 (Annexure P-3) has also been submitted before the respondent

authorities.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner side, the directions are issued to the respondent authorities to duly consider representation dated 20.06.2020 (Annexure P-3) of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to him without any delay as per law.
