The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of directions to the official respondents No.2 and 3 to take the appropriate legal action against respondents No.4 to 11 on the complaint dated 01.03.2021 filed by the petitioner for registration of case under Sections 406, 498-A, 323, 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 for harassing the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite complaints having been made to the authorities concerned, no action has been taken by the official respondents. He submits that petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate direction is issued to respondent No.2-the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar (Rural) to look into the complaint dated 01.03.2021 (Annexure P-2) submitted by her and take appropriate action under the provisions of law.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Luvinder Sofat, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

Keeping in view the limited prayer addressed by the learned counsel for the petitioner, respondent No.2-the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar (Rural), Punjab is directed to look into the complaint dated 01.03.2021 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner and take appropriate steps/action, if any, required under the provisions of law. However, if the respondent No.2 does not find any substance or merit in the allegations levelled by the petitioner, much less, commission of cognizable offences, the petitioner would be duly informed as per the parameters laid down by the apex Court in **Lalita Kumari** Vs. **Government of Uttar Pradesh and Others**; 2013 (4) RCR (Criminal) 979.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
