The petitioner in the present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeks directions for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant exemption from type test in consonance with circulars dated 11.09.1972 (Annexure P-1) and 26.06.1975 (Annexure P-2). Further directions are also sought for grant of ACP benefits as prayed for in representations dated 04.07.2019 (Annexure P-5) and 25.09.2020 (Annexure P-6).

Counsel has submitted that being a ex-serviceman he is exempted from the mandatory type test having served in the Indian Navy for over 20 years. He further submits that he would be satisfied if the representation dated 25.09.2020 (Annexure P-6) is decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Kumar Nain, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

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Keeping in view the limited controversy as such and since the decision making is still incomplete, no useful purpose will be served to call upon the respondents for filing reply, as it would cause further delay in deciding the proceedings.

Accordingly, without commenting on the merits of the case or entitlement of the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with the directions to the respondents to take a decision on the representation dated 25.09.2020 (Annexure P-6) within a period of 3 months from the receipt of the certified copy of this order. In case the the relief is to be denied, reasoned order be passed and communicated to the petitioner.
