The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure by the petitioners, seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0139 dated 06.09.2019, under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B of the IPC, registered at Police Station Kartarpur, District Jalandhar (Rural).

2. Respondent No.2/complainant – Smt. Paramjit Kaur has appeared personally through WhatsApp video call and has submitted that the dispute between her and the accused persons in the case has already been amicably compromised and, therefore, she does not oppose the bail prayer of the petitioners.

3. In view of the aforesaid submission, the petitioners' prayer for

Anticipatory Bail is allowed and they are ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (Challan). They shall continue to join investigation and shall furnish an undertaking that they shall abide by the conditions specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Thereafter, the petitioners will be permitted to furnish bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court.
