Prayer in the instant petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to open the proceedings of the DPC held on 13.11.2017 wherein, the result of the petitioner for promotion to the post of Senior Medical Officer was kept in sealed cover and thereafter to promote the petitioner as Senior Medical Officer on the basis of the result and grant all consequential benefits including seniority, arrears of pay and further promotion.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, instead of pressing the present petition on merits, states that his client would be satisfied in case, representation dated 11.04.2019 (P-2) is considered and decided by passing a speaking order expeditiously.

Prayer seems to be justified.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Sunint Kaur, AAG, Punjab, who is present through video-conference, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Learned State counsel raises no objection to the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the consensus arrived at between both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2, to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 11.04.2019 (P-2), in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from today.
