The petitioner herein seeks the quashing of the FIR bearing No.152 registered at Police Station Nahianwala, District Bathinda on 23.11.2018 under Sections 406 and 420 IPC as well as Section 7 of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955 and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Ms. Samina Dhir, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, has joined the proceedings in this case on behalf of respondent No.1-State in pursuance of the copy of this petition having been sent to this respondent in advance.
