The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of a direction to official respondent No.2 to conduct fair and impartial investigation and to arrest the accused.

Counsel submits that before approaching this Court, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 01.06.2021 (Annexure P-3) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda-respondent No.2, however, the same has not been attended to. Counsel submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the concerned respondent to look into the representation.

Without expressing any opinion on the allegations made in the petition or in the representation, the petition is disposed of with a direction
