The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code
of Criminal Procedure by the petitioner, seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR
No.0139 dated 06.09.2019, under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B of the IPC,
registered at Police Station Kartarpur, District Jalandhar (Rural).

2. Respondent No.2/complainant – Smt. Paramjit Kaur has appeared

personally through WhatsApp video call and has submitted that the dispute between her and the accused in the case has already been amicably compromised and, therefore, she does not oppose the bail prayer of the petitioner.

3. In view of the aforesaid submission, the petitioner's prayer for Anticipatory Bail is allowed and he is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (Challan). He shall continue to join investigation and shall furnish an undertaking that he shall abide by the conditions specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. Thereafter, the petitioner will be permitted to furnish bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court.
