The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of a direction to official respondents to adhere to the complaint and representation dated 27.04.2021 and 31.05.2021 (Annexures P-2 and P-5 respectively) and redress the grievance of the petitioner by taking appropriate action by ordering registration of FIR against respondents No.5 to 8 keeping in view the guidelines as laid down by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in ***Lalita Kumari Versus Govt. of UP and Others AIR 2014 (SC) 187***, as perusal of the MLR and complaint (Annexures P-1 and P-2) shows that a cognizable offence is made out.

During the course of argument, counsel for the petitioner submits that before approaching this Court, the petitioner has submitted representation dated 31.05.2021 (Annexure P-5) a copy of which has been

sent by e-mail to Superintendent of Police, Nuh Mewat – respondent No.3, however, the same has not been attended to. Counsel submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the concerned respondent to look into the representation.

Request made by the counsel has been considered.

Without expressing any opinion on the allegations made in the petition or in the representation, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Superintendent of Police, Nuh-Mehwat – respondent No.3 to examine the representation dated 31.05.2021 (Annexure P-5) submitted by the petitioner and thereafter to take appropriate steps as warranted in accordance with law.

A copy of the representation dated 31.05.2021 (Annexure P-5) along with the petition be communicated to respondent No.3 so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
