The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking grant of protection to life and liberty of the present petitioners.

Notice of motion was issued in this case and the State has filed short reply in the form of reply by way of affidavit of Sanjeev Kumar, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Licensing & Security, Amritsar City on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. The said reply is taken on record.

As per the reply it has been stated that the statements of the petitioners were recorded by the police and they have no threat or danger from the private respondents and they have stated that they do not require any kind of security and respondents No.4 and 5 have stated that they do not have any objection to the live-in relationship of the petitioners.

However, the petitioners had been advised by the SHO, Police Station Kot Khalsa, Amritsar City that if they have any kind of grievance or feel danger from anyone then they may inform the local police and their grievance would be redressed in accordance with law.

The learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that in view of the reply filed by the State, he does not wish to press the present petition and wants to withdraw the same.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
