Prayer in the instant petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to rectify the anomaly in the pay scale of petitioners viz-a-viz the Clerks and to pay the arrears of revised pay, conveyance allowance and special pay w.e.f. 01.12.2011 along with interest @ 18% per annum.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, on instructions, states that his clients would be satisfied in case, legal notice dated 25.05.2021 (P-3) is considered and decided by passing a speaking order expeditiously.

Prayer seems to be justified.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG, Punjab, who is present through video-conference, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Learned State counsel raises no objection against the

innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioners.

In view of the consensus arrived at between both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2, to consider and decide the aforesaid legal notice dated 25.05.2021 (P-3), in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably within a period of (04) four months from today.
