1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., is for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 & 3 to take appropriate action in case FIR No.63 dated 22.05.2021 registered under Sections 326, 324, 323, 341, 506, 148 & 149 IPC at Police Station Sadar Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur as despite registration of the FIR, the police is not taking appropriate action in the matter on the ground that enquiry has been marked in the matter at the instance of the accused to Amritsar Police etc.

3. Learned counsel states that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur to consider the petition as a representation and take a decision on the claim of the petitioner and

action in respect thereto in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.

4. Notice to respondent No.2 only.

5. Mr. Hittan Nehra, learned Addl. AG, Punjab, accepts notice and after perusal of the same states that he has no objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, in the light of the position noted above, the instant petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur, to consider the instant petition as a representation and take a decision on the claim made in the same and action pursuant to the decision as is warranted in the facts and circumstances of the case, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible.

7. Petition disposed of with the aforementioned directions.
